What is NASCO ITC about

NASCO ICT (nascoict.org) is a very young NGO that aims to create a network of computers classrooms in rural schools in Ghana to give ICT knowledge to young students in disadvantaged communities. NASCO ICT collect, update and reuse unused computers of people and companies of Europe and send them to schools in Ghana.

Why to help?

Ousman Umar left his hometown in Ghana when he was 9 years old. His aim, as many others, was getting into Europe. He felt twice in the hands of the mafia, but five countries and five years later Ousman reached Barcelona. He was lucky enough to meet a family who host him and that allowed him to go from practically illiterate to a university student. Ousman is aware that his case is exceptional and that's why he has started this NGO, to help children of Ghana have access to education and information. Along with his biological brother they have started NASCO ICT which already has more than 850 students.

"Only through education we can offer real opportunities for progress". That is why they seek for assistance in the development and sustainability of the NGO.
